

It is proposed to fill up one vacancy of Joint Commissioner in the Office of the Competent Authority and Administrator, Delhi on deputation basis.

2. As per Recruitment Rules, the post of Joint Commissioner, in the Office of the Competent Authority is classified as General Central Service, Group 'A' Gazetted, Non-Ministerial. The pay scale is Rs.15600-39100 with grade pay Rs.7600. The method of recruitment is by deputation. Grades from which deputation is to be made are:

Officers under the Central Government:

- (i) Holding analogous posts on a regular basis in the present cadre or department; or
- (ii) with five years' service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on regular basis in the scale of pay Rs.15600-39100 with grade pay Rs.6600 or equivalent in the parent cadre or department; and
- (iii) possessing 10 years' experience in enforcement of regulatory laws or investigation of offences and collection of intelligence relating thereto.


(Period of deputation including the period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization or department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed four years. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation shall not exceed 56 years as on the closing date of receipt of application).

Subject: Preparation of Panel for selection for the posts of Superintendent (Group B) on deputation in the Directorate of Legal Affairs, New Delhi.

It is proposed to draw a panel of suitable and eligible officers for the posts of Superintendent, in the scale of pay of Rs.9300-34800 with GP Rs.4800/- or above in PB-2 to be filled up on deputation basis amongst officers who are and working in the grade of Superintendent, in the Directorate of Legal Affairs, at New Delhi.

2. The period of deputation for the selected person, would ordinarily for three years. The officers on deputation will be entitled to a Special Pay (Allowance) @ 5% / 10% of their basic pay during the tenure of their posting as Superintendent in this Directorate. Cadre control for the purpose of promotion etc. of such staff would continue with parent cadre controlling Commissionerate to which such deputed person belongs.
